

EPR/CTS/PVC Type MV-105, Power 25kV 133% 320mils- Silicone Free Three Conductor, Copper

DESCRIPTION

The three conductor MV-105 power cables consist of Bare Copper Class B stranded conductors, covered with ethylene propylene rubber (EPR), copper tape shield, an uninsulated Bare Copper Ground, and Black PVC jacket.

APPLICATIONS

- Primary installations include cable trays, and outdoor locations: sunlight resistant and direct burial. In conduit, duct, free air, raceways.
- In wet or dry locations. Rated 105°C wet or dry.
- Approved for Class I, Div. 2 industrial hazardous locations per NEC
- For CT use for per UL 1072
- Designed to operate continuously at a conductor temperature not exceeding
 - » 105°C for normal operations
 - » 140°C for emergency overload
 - » 250°C for short circuit
