

TR-XLPE/CN/XLPE, Type MV-105, Primary UD, 35kV 133%, 420-MILS Single Conductor Filled Aluminum -Silicone Free

DESCRIPTION

This specification covers cables that consist of Aluminum filled conductor, covered with tree-retardant cross-linked polyethylene (TR-XLPE), a concentric neutral of helically applied copper wires, and a cross-linked polyethylene (XLPE) jacket.

APPLICATIONS

- Suitable for underground primary power applications: direct burial or in duct.
- For wet or dry locations
- Jacket is sunlight resistant, meeting the 720-hr exposure test
- · Excellent resistance to treeing
- Designed to operate continuously at a conductor temperature not exceeding
- > 105°C for normal operations
- > 140°C for emergency overload
- > 250°C for short circuit
